Hang 21 Surf Event in Tofino with Greater Victoria Down Syndrome Society: An annual surfing event designed to empower individuals with Down syndrome. Participants take to the waves under the guidance of experienced surf instructors who provide personalized support and encouragement. Fees: Families are responsible for travel and food costs. GVDSS and other sponsors cover the equipment and accommodation.

Butchart Gardens: a beautiful garden open year-round, with accessibility options, including access to wheelchairs (with a refundable fee), strollers, benches throughout the park, wheelchair-friendly paths, access to food and drink and more! Tickets can be purchased with discounts (not passes) for military personnel. If you live on the island, buying an annual pass is equivalent to 2 visits, and well worth the purchase!

Malahat Skywalk: open year round the skywalk is a spiraling ramp tower offering a smooth climb to the top with stunning views of the ocean and forest. The trip back down is even faster with a spiral slide all the way down!
