Lights at LaFarge: Metro Vancouver's largest free outdoor winter lights display, featuring a 1.6-km pathway filled with dazzling lights and re-imagined displays. The display runs until Monday, February 16, 2026—stay tuned to our website and social channels for updates throughout the season.

Pathways are lit and user-friendly for visitors of all abilities. The 1.6-km trail is flat and mostly paved, accessible by strollers and mobility devices, although there is one section of finely packed gravel.
