


Canada Disability Benefit (CDB)

Learn more about the new Canada Disability Benefit (CDB), launched in June of 2025. Follow the links for more information on eligibility and how to apply.


The Canada Disability Benefit (CDB) is a monthly payment for all adults aged 18-64 persons with disabilities in Canada who have low income.



How do I know if I am eligible for CDB?

1. Be a Resident of Canada [for Income Tax Purposes](#)
2. Approved for Disability Tax Credit
3. Between ages of 18-64
4. Up to date on your tax filing

Note: If the person is married or in a common-law relationship, their spouse or common-law partner must also file an income tax return with the Canada Revenue Agency for the previous tax year.



What steps do I take to apply?

1. File your income tax for the previous year
2. Apply for Disability Tax Credit. Please visit our [DTC page](#) for help
3. Prepare your application for the Canadian Disability Benefit [online](#) or call Service Canada at 1-833-486-3007



How much is it?

The maximum amount of the Canada Disability Benefit will be up to \$200 per month, or \$2,400 annually (July to June). The amount someone will receive will depend on their income and the income of their spouse or common-law partner, if they have one. Check out the [Canada Disability Benefit Estimator tool](#) to calculate how much you may receive.

Retroactive payments for up to 2 years:

You can get payments for all the months you were eligible, starting from June 2025, even if you apply many months later.
